Multicultural Association's Financial Literacy Program reopening for Fall 2020 registration

Financial Literacy Program for Newcomers back in classroom

Fort McMurray, AB/ August 21, 2020 – The Multicultural Association of Wood Buffalo (MCA) is reopening its Financial Literacy Program for fall classes this September with appropriate social-distancing measures.

The Financial Literacy Program will reopen as an in-person class in the Keyano Theatre location, with a maximum capacity of 30 participants per session level. The MCA is taking social distancing precautions and will be providing hand sanitizer at each session. Masks will be required for attendees.

This program is designed to introduce Newcomers to Canada to the Canadian financial system. It is open to registration for anyone interested in honing their financial knowledge, with two tiers of instruction that aim to help participants build skills around managing personal finances. The Level 1 program session is designed to give students the fundamental skills for managing finances. The Level 2 program takes participants to the next level, focusing on: the concept of money and establishing financial goals, determining net worth, evaluating company stocks and private offerings, real estate investing, how to avoid fraud or scam, and Internet and network marketing.

The cost to register is \$25, with this amount refunded to participants who attend at least 80 per cent of the classes.
